Responsibilities/Skills:

- Work in concert with the CFM team to determine specific opportunities for measuring the economic impacts of policies and programs that impact Mississippi's 0–5-year-old population;
- Provide input to developing survey items to be fielded to the business sector in Mississippi to address both the current and future workforce in Mississippi;
- Provide economic impact statements and resultant policy brief(s) on the impact on the availability, affordability, and quality of early care and education in Mississippi, specific to the business/workforce development;
- Proficiency in relevant software packages for data analysis;
- Develop a strategic plan to measure the economic impact of quality early care and education in Mississippi;
- Present findings (both in-person and virtual), as requested by the CFM/PDG team to both internal and external audiences;
- Excellent communication skills (oral and written) including the ability to synthesize complex findings for non-technical audiences;
- Ability to use relevant software packages for data analysis

Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in economics preferred OR master's degree in economics with a minimum of 5 years of experience
- Demonstrated knowledge of survey development, data collection, data analysis, and report writing
