

How do we use this?

"Seats per Child" indicates the total capacity of centerbased and home-based childcare providers in each county divided by the number of children living there. The higher the number is, the more seats are available in that county. The counties in Table 1 have at least one seat for each child in their county. In comparison, the counties in Table 2 have far fewer seats than they have children.

Another way of reading this would be that Sharkey County (right) has enough childcare capacity for roughly 5% of the children living there. In comparison, Benton County (above) has more seats than the number of children living there.



Distribution of Licensed Center-Based



While knowing the capacity of centers across a county is critical, the number of providers available by county broadens our understanding of the childcare landscape and parents' choices within it. Children with special needs often require specialized services. The fewer providers there are, the less likely it is that these services are available. Parents in counties with only one or two providers are much more likely to travel outside of the county to access childcare.
